We invite your kind attention to the discussions held in the meeting on 25th December 2004 at your Hon'ble Self's residence at New Delhi. As per the discussions held in the meeting, on 29.12.2004 we forwarded a detailed letter highlighting on the genuine issues of the AIACE/Federation, in relation to its recognition as per CCS(RSA) Rules-1993 as well as Dr. Mashelkar's anti-employee/undemocratic attitude. A copy of this letter is enclosed herewith for ready reference of the Hon'ble Sir.

It is more than 3½ months, no development has taken place in this regard. The situation remains the same – no correspondence, no dialogues, no positive indication by the DGCSIR to restore the cordial relationship between the representatives and CSIR Management. Let alone granting recognition to AIACE/Federation, atleast a meeting with the representatives has also not been held by DGCSIR.

Sir, we appeal to you to kindly intervene into this matter in order to uphold democracy in the CSIR system, and prima facie see that the DGCSIR holds a meeting with the representatives of AIACE/Federation at the earliest. We are sure that this meeting will help both the employees and CSIR Management to amicably resolve the issues faced by the AIACE/Federation in relation to granting recognition. Sir, while we look forward for favourable and needful action at the very earliest, we express once again our sincere thanks for holding a meeting with the representatives on 25.12.2004.

We earnestly request your Hon'ble Self to please take immediate action on the matter as mentioned in the enclosed letter.
