Dear Friends,

Three days before, I received a letter from Shri K.D.Sharma detailing on the following points :  
Mr. J.Sundaresh Pillai has joined NISTADS (Now NISCAIR), New Delhi in February 2007 as per the court's order along with all the backwages. He requested me to talk Mr. Pillai on this matter and to explore whether we can revive the Federation. Consequently, I spoke to Mr. Pillai. I congratulated him. He told me that he along with around 75 representatives met at Delhi on 8th April 2007 and discuss ways and means to revive the CSIR-SWA. They decided to take the Federation along with them so that both the organizations could be revived. On 9th April 2007, around 6-7 representatives met Dr.T.Ramasami and held discussions with him. I was told that he was receptive and discussions were constructive, besides himself being positive. Based on this telephonic conversation, the Following Letter has already been sent to Dr. T.Ramasami, Addl. DGCSIR, which is self-explanatory.
