MEMORANDUM TO THE HON'BLE PRIME MINISTER OF INDIA (Chairman, Cauvery River Authority)

The staff members of Central Food Technological Research Institute, Mysore, under the auspices of CFTRI Employees' Union and CFTRI-SWA held a Peaceful RALLY/MARCH in Mysore City on 11.10.2002 starting at 11.00 AM. The Rally covering the important streets of Mysore, was held to protest against the direction of the Central Government to Karnataka to Release Cauvery Water to Tamilnadu and to extend implicit support to the on-going struggle of the farmers/people under the banner of Cauvery Kriya Samithi. This decision of the Central Government has caused unimaginable hardship to the Karnataka farmers and people in general, and Mysore and its surrounding area farmers/people in particular.

More than 500 staff members including temporary staff participated in the Rally. All the members expressed their utmost solidarity to the noble cause for which all the farmers and people from different walks of life are struggling for.

Further, all the staff members unanimously RESOLVED that the Hon'ble Prime Minister should facilitate resolving this vex and long pending matter amicably through tripartite negotiations involving Central Government, Karnataka Government and Tamilnadu Government.

As all the staff members are aware, various All-India Trade Unions and Confederation of Central Government Employees and Workers have given a call to all the Central/State Government employees, Private/PSU Workers and General Citizens from all walks of life to observe **All-India Strike on 29.09.2005** in support of various demands which have a direct bearing on all the workers/citizens and the country as a whole.

In order to convey our solidarity support to the All-India Strike Call and strongly protest against the autocratic, anti-employee and anti-Union/Association attitude of DGCSIR, the All-India Association of CSIR Employees/Federation has given a Call to all its affiliated units to support the **Strike Call by observing Protest Day**. Accordingly, the Executive Committee of CFTRI Employees' Union has proposed to observe **PROTEST DAY** on Thursday the **29th September 2005** in support of the following main National and CSIR related Demands :

National Level Demands : (1) Guarantee Right to Strike (2) Constitution of VI Pay Commission to CG Employees (3) Increasing the existing Ceiling Limit of Bonus to Non-Profit CG Organizations (4) No Privatization of Defence Establishments/Profit Making PSUs (5) Ban on Contractual Appointments and Regularization of Existing Contract Workers (6) Increase Regular Appointments in Government Sectors, etc.

CSIR Demands : (1) DGCSIR to immediately invite representatives of AIACE/Federation for Discussions (2) DGCSIR to immediately Grant Recognition to AIACE/Federation as per CCS(RSA) Rules-1993 or Enforce Trade Union Rights in CSIR (3) DGCSIR to immediately Grant two increments and Rs.5000/- per year to all the CSIR Staff Members on par with that of the Group-IV Scientists, etc.

2. Assembling in front of the Canteen at 10.30 AM on 29.09.2005
3. Speeches by the representatives

Under the banner of CFTRI Employees' Union, more than 800 Staff Members and Scientists of CFTRI participated in the Protest March held on 15th March 2007 at 10.15 AM in the Main Streets of Mysore. All the Staff Members and Scientists unanimously conveyed their strong Protests against the Final Order of the Cauvery Water Disputes Tribunal, and urged the Central Government to QUASH this Final Order and refer this Dispute to the Hon'ble Supreme Court. Further, they urged the Karnataka Government to appoint High Profile Legal Experts who are sincere, efficient and have an unblemished record, in order to argue the Karnataka Government's case before the Supreme Court with full/vital facts and figures connected with fair/equitable sharing of the Cauvery Water.


